1. September – Three-side project with the Institute of Information Technology in Education UNESCO and company “SVEGA-Computer”, “Using 3D technologies in educational process – master-class for the teachers of the IT of Primorskii region “New digital technologies in education , “Round-table” together with the assistant director of Lyceum №39 from Ufa Republic Bashkortosta A.H. Ahmetova and representatives “ SVEGA-Computer”
2. March 2019 – Petersburg International Educational Forum - 2019. VII Interregional Science-Technical conference Day of IT “Digital technologies and IT in Education. 3D stereo visualization as an instrument of presenting subject area in modern pedagogy. March 26, 2019 in Lyceum №554 there was VII Interregional Science-technical conference visited by more than 100 representatives of pedagogical society from St-Petersburg, different regions of Russia and foreign countries.
3. March 2019 – Lyceum participated in the project APPO “ Net society “ Digital schools” on the topic “Formation of the system of pre-professional competences of natural-science profile of in using 3D in educational process and the platform of electronic education “Russian electronic school”
4. 27 April – Students of the Lyceum presented their work “Ecological Home” at the International conference in Magnitogorsk “ Stable development of the city. Agrosphere.” Under the leadership of Topilskaya T.V.(teacher of Technology) and Gofman O.V.(teacher of English) a report was made in English.
5. From November 25 to 29, 2019, the UNESCO IITE 2019 was held in St. Petersburg. Director of the Lyceum Bezborodaya I.N., Deputy Director Novik L.V. took part in the UNESCO IITE Week 2019. and teachers Kashin I.A., Poshekhonov I.S. and Scherbakova N.V. They shared their experience in implementing 3D stereo imaging technology in the educational process. And also took part in the competition for teachers and took first place.

- Conservation of Worldwide cultural and natural inheritance, saving it and development of creative potential

1. November 2018 – Lyceum`s newspaper “220 Volt” won in the All-Russian competition among school issues “ The Best Material in Art”
2. January 2019 – 6 students of Lyceum took part in the contest “ Poems and ME” in the Gymnasium 67(organized after UNESCO). Baskakov Aleksei was the winner with his poem “ The Flight Above the City”.
3. March 2019 – Conference “ From stable development to the conservation of Worldwide inheritance, devoted to 65th anniversary of UNESCO Associated Schools: history, experiment, perspective”. The meeting was held 26.03.2019 like “ Auction of the Pedagogical Ideas” together with the Institute of IT in Education UNESCO and the company “SVEGA-Computer. The teacher of physics Nekludov Rodion Aleksandrovich presented his work of using 3D technologies studying physics.
4. March 2019 – 27.03.2019 VIII Interregional conference “On the way to the Health School: potential of digital education.” The teachers of the Lyceum Aleksandrova O.A., Kashina I.A., Stepanova N.N., Petuhova T.S. presented their work in using 3D technologies at the lessons on the topic “ Health at School”
5. Participation in the All-Russian correspondence literary competition in English "Bookworm" among the UNESCO ASPnet of the Russian Federation. Pupils of our Lyceum Volkov Alexander (9th grade) and Gribanov Ulyana (7th grade) became winners of the second degree and third degree. Teachers - Hoffman O.V. and Cornet N.A.
6. On December 17, 2019, on the basis of SBEI Lyceum No. 554, the City webinar “In the World of the Wonderful: UNESCO Heritage” was held (as part of an open dialogue). The participants in the webinar were welcomed by Tamara Vlasova, coordinator of the UNESCO Associated Schools project in the Baltika-North region, director of school No. 1 with in-depth study of English in the Moscow region of St. Petersburg. She emphasized the importance of preserving the heritage of UNESCO, emphasized the relevance of the theme of the webinar.
7. 2019 is officially declared the year of the Theater in Russia. In this regard, the Regional Coordination Center of the UNESCO-Baltic Baltics North Associated Schools Network, together with the St. Petersburg Academy of Postgraduate Pedagogical Education and the St. Petersburg State Budgetary Institution of Culture “Puppet Theater of a Fairytale” held the All-Russian contest “The Magic World of Theater” as part of a regional project “Preserving the World Cultural

and Natural Heritage” in accordance with the goals of sustainable development.

Pupils of the Lyceum together with the organizing teacher T. Pogoreloy took an active part in the workshops.

- Learn to live together

1. On April 22, 23 2019 Lyceum 554 had Lyceum`s Readings “Man`s health through the students` research projects”. 20 works by the students from Sevastopol, Rostov-on-Don, Ekaterinburg, Moscow, Volgograd, Samara, Tatarstan of UNESCO Associated Schools were presented.

2. Concerts for sick, disabled, old, foster homes were held during the year.

3. Participation in the profile shift of the League of volunteer squads within the framework of the All-Russian project # you talk about as winners of the All-Russian contest “Welcome does not go on vacation” in the nomination “Best Practices” (ICC “Artek”) - August-September 2019. Detachment Lyceum 554 became the Winner, and Lyashchenko Tatyana became the Ambassador of the League of volunteer teams from St. Petersburg.

4. Participation of students and teachers of the Lyceum in the Interregional rally “Young Patriots of Russia” in Volgograd as part of the implementation of the interregional patriotic project “I Am Part of Russia!” And cooperation with Volgograd schools (October 2019).

- Building the society of knowledge

1. March 29, 2019 – the Secretary of the Affairs Commission of UNESCO in the Russian Federation, the Ambassador for special Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia Ordshonikidze Grigorii Eduardovich. The Lyceum is a participant of two International educational projects of UNESCO: UNESCO Associated School” and the experimental centre in using 3D technologies in educational process together with the UNESCO Institute and “SVEGA-Computer” company. The questions of the projects and modern education were discussed at the meeting. The project about the multilingual schools Russia triggers in UNESCO was discussed in details.

2. March 6, 2019 – Interdistrict Web conference on topic “Introduction of the technology of visualization in the process of education in schools” was held. Director`s assistant in innovations of IMC of Primorsky district Poltorackaya Irina Victorovna, Nikolaev Sergei Vasilevich, the candidate of pedagogical sciences, docent of the LSU named after A.S.Pushkin, Kozunenko Dmitry Aleksandrovich, the deputy general director of IT” SVEGA-Computer”. The teachers of the Lyceum(Novic L.V., Kondrateva E.I., technologies. The teachers from school 500 of Pushkin district and from school 81 Kalinin district showed their works in the digitalization of the education.

3. April 2019 – Took part in MISE (Moscow International Salon of Education) from 10-13. The Company “SVEGA-Computer” presented their decisions in cluster “Additional Education”, showing new possibilities of using Universal mobile multimedia complex with 3D visualization. The principle of the lyceum Bezborodaya I.N. and the assistant Novik L.V. presented the experience of the Lyceum in “ Using 3D technologies in Studies” on the three-side pilot prolect together with Institute UNESCO and Company “ SVEGA-Computer”.

4. April, 24 – The teacher of Physics Sherbakova N.V. presented her experience at the seminar of professional-pedagogical society of “digital schools” in St-Peterburgs, named “ Opportunities of the digital educational sphere for the development of the individuality of the students”.

5. On November 26, 2019, on the basis of SBEI Lyceum 554, a city seminar "New Digital Technologies in Classroom and Extracurricular Activities" was held. The seminar discussed the introduction of new digital technologies in the educational process, hardware and software were presented: a multimedia 3D stereo imaging complex developed by SVEGA-Computer LLC, a 3D printer, Eureka software and free software for creating educational projects. The seminar was attended by: Gaisina S. V., Senior Lecturer, Department of Basic and Secondary General Education, St. Petersburg APPO, I. Kochneva, Director of the Center for Contemporary Art, Labetskiy M. I., Project Manager, SVEGA-Computer LLC, Poltoratskaya IV. , deputy director of the IMC of Primorsky district and teacher Lyceum 554. More than 80 teachers of the district and city attended the seminar.

- Science in the interests of the stable future

1. October 24, 2018 – there was a district teaching seminar “ Integration of 3D technologies into the process of education”. 42 teachers were present there.
2. November 2018 – Books about the recommendations of using 3D visualization SVEGA and the software provision “Evrika” during the lessons of natural science were published.
3. X All-Russian conference with the International participation “ Information Technology for a new school” was held on 27 March, 2019 in Lyceum 554, there was a seminar “ Innovations in education: 3D technologies at the lessons and extracurricular activities. More than 80 teachers from St-Petersburg and different regions of Russia visited them.
4. In April-May 2019 the students of the Lyceum took part in the VIII All-Russian festival of school science UNESCO Associated Schools “Student in modern world”. 3 works were sent there. Borisov Danila, Kaltigin Igor, Shvetc Aleksei got the diplomas of laureates. Borodin Nikita got the certificate of the participant.

Celebrations of the International Days UNO and UNESCO were held in the Lyceum during the year at the lessons and extracurricular activities in different forms: class hours, presentations, video lessons, newspapers were published, festivals, competitions and quizzes were organized.

The Lyceum has developed a volunteer and patriotic movement: participation in the city event "Days of the White Cranes" (laying flowers and white cranes), participation in the city action "Memorial Day" laying flowers at the Alley of Heroes of the Suvorov School, participation and victory in the city competition of youth initiatives " Green Light ", participation in the Interregional“ round table ”“ Living Victory Stories ”within the framework of the interregional patriotic project“ I Am Part of Russia! ”, Meeting and giving gifts to the mothers of Beslan at the exhibition“ Remember ... ”as part of tion of inter-patriotic project "I - part of Russia!", participated in the All-Russia forum of volunteers "Dobroforum".

7. Observed change or improvement

- *This section gathers information on the changes resulting from ASPnet activities at the student, school and community level. Student level:

According to state final certificate of the students from the 11 grade of Lyceum 554 is in the list of 10% best in the city among the educational institutions. School leavers demonstrate great results in Biology (average score – 70), Chemistry (3 students got 100 points, 90 points – 3 students, the average score - 73), Physics (average score – 72).

Students of the 9 grade also had high results. Our students got higher results in the city in Physics (average score – 4,00), in Biology (4,22), in Chemistry (4,53), in Geography (4,04), in Maths (3,97), in IT (4,2)

Lyceum took part all-Russian checking works. The most successful subject was Biology in all the classes.

Participation in the all-Russian Olympiad was a great success too. One winner in the regional part, 3 prizewinners in Chemistry, 3 prizewinners Biology, 1 – Astronomy, 1 – in Geography, 2 – in History, 1 – in Physics. The number Of winners and prizewinners increased in comparison with the previous year.

Taking part in other projects of UAS resulted in changing of students` attitude to disabled people old and sick. Students began to help them in different situations.

School level:

The participation in the project with the Institute of Information Technology in education UNESCO and company “ SVEGA-Computer” in using 3d technology in education led to wider distribution of new way in teaching, that resulted in better marks.

Extracurricular activities had great impact too. Students and their parents became more active.
